Bookout http://bookoutapp.com/	(iPhone – free/in app purchases) - keep track of your books, make a habit out of reading & see how you evolve over time, gathers reading stats & helps maintain your focus (good for kids/parents)
Ireaditnow (coming to the web soon) http://ireaditnow.net/	(iPhone, iPad – coming soon to the Web (Free/\$2.99 iPad) - listserv - I use it to keep track of the books I've read during the year. Works pretty well!
Litsy http://litsy.com/	(iPhone, Android, iPad - free) - listserv - I just discovered Litsy earlier this week. It's a bookish social media app where you can track what you're reading, share quotes from books and reviews of book, and find other people who are reading the same book or who have similar tastes to you.

Dropbox https://dropbox.com	(Android, iPhone, iPad, mac, windows - free but - costs more if you want more storage [1 TB] / in app purchases/subscription) – drop in photos, docs, videos & other files, sync between all devices, good for sending large files, can send to others even if they don't have a Dropbox account
Padlet https://padlet.com/	(iPhone & Android - Free BUT different plans – school, business, home & price (school \$1499 all the way down to \$5.00 monthly for teachers) - Collects your thoughts, links, video, text, images & share or private, brainstorming, collaborative & work together (PowerPoint slides)
Trello https://trello.com/platforms	(iPhone, Android, Web & iPad - Free/in app purchases) – an awesome project management tool, whether you are making a grocery list, writing a screenplay or a department's work – assign tasks, attach photos, vids, files, customize workflows
Google Hangouts https://hangouts.google.com/	(iPhone, Android, Web [Chrome], iPad – free) – Video call, phone call or message or draw images like a white board, take pictures (I've used for bi-weekly meetings)

1Password https://1password.com	(iPhone, Android, Web, iPad – free/in app purchases) - remembers all your passwords and other sensitive information safe behind one password that you only know, can sign in to websites & apps with a few taps & also has a password generator – I need to check this one out because I keep forgetting my passwords!

Unroll.me https://unroll.me/app/	(iPhone – free) - Decluttering your inbox tool • UNSUBSCRIBE - from unwanted emails • ROLLUP - Consolidate sales/newsletters/listserv into one daily digest • KEEP – the emails you want in your inbox
Evernote https://evernote.com/	(Can use on all devices & syncs between) - free but different subscription packages – 60 MB space free per month
Cam Scanner https://www.camscanner.com/	(iPhone, Android & iPad - free/99 cents/\$4.99/in app purchases) – can scan documents with your phone (works well with Evernote) – receipts, bills, pics ...
Penultimate https://evernote.com/penultimate/	(iPad only – free/in app purchases) (use with Evernote) - A pioneer among handwriting apps for iPad, it has only improved since its 2010 debut. It’s great for taking notes, sketching projects, or simply doodling the hours away – and now, with recently added Evernote integration, it’s a better productivity than ever before.
