





## Types of Briefs

### Certiorari-stage brief

- Certiorari-stage briefs are the efforts by parties to tell the court why it should or should not take a case.
- Once the Supreme Court has granted certiorari in a case, each party has the opportunity to file merits briefs.

### **Merits briefs**

 Unlike the certioraristage briefs, which tell the court why it should or should not take the case, the merits briefs tell the court why each party thinks it deserves to win.

### **Amicus Curiae brief**

- "Friend of the court" brief; a brief filed by a person, group or entity that is not a party to the case but nonetheless wishes to provide the court with its perspective on the issue before it.
- The person or entity is called an "amicus"; the plural is "amici."




The full names of the parties.

The docket or case numbers of the original case, as well as any appeals. The location of the court in which the case was filed, as well as the courts of any appeals.

The date (exact or approximate) of the case and any appeals. The names of judges and/or attorneys involved in the case.

Twelve people from diverse backgrounds in the law media, government, and academia have been selected for a new public user group to provide advice and feedback on ways to improve the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) service and other electronic public access services provided by the Judiciary. #### FREE ACCESS TO COURT RECORDS INCREASES IN 2020

Beginning Jan. 1, 2020, if a PACER user quarterly usage is \$30 or less, the bill will be waived. This is an increase from the existing \$15 or less quarterly fee waiver. Users will see this reflected in the April 2020 billing statement. This will result in more than 75 percent of users accessing court records paying no fee in a given quarter. The Judicial Conference approved this action at their September 17, 2019, meeting.

The Federal Judiciary has developed a Next Generation (NextGen) Case Management/ Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system that will allowyou to use the same account for both PACER and electronic filing access.
