INSPIRE and New User Interfaces from EBSCO

This is what I know about libraries having different version of the UI when accessing links:

- Accessing any of the interfaces discussed from the INSPIRE site should resolve to new UI's.
 Sometimes users may access through the INSPIRE site and then revert to their own organization access through IP recognition—this is where users may see something different
- All/most public and school libraries should have all of the new user interfaces. If they do not, they can request any interface be updated to new through EBSCO support.
- Academic libraries should NOT have new UI's unless they have requested this change. They can request preview access to anything new and/or ask for any interface to be updated to new through EBSCO support https://connect.ebsco.com/
