
- Armed conflict, disaster exposure, gender inequality, lack of job opportunities, political corruption, and lack of access to competent healthcare and education




IN 2005, A study by former First Lady of Indianapolis, Amy Minick Peterson, and the Greater Indianapolis Progress Committee (GIPC) researched various immigrant populations and their needs,

They facilitated focus groups with service providers, and studied best practices in other cities for assisting immigrants and refugees.

BY 2006, The Immigrant Welcome Center, as it is known today, was established with the help of 12 volunteers known as Natural Helpers.


TOP COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN
