LIFE PRO TIPS: MANAGE YOUR MANAGER

Tips on how to foster open communication, trust, and develop rapport with your manager.

TIP 1: BE HONEST

- When your manager asks you about your workplace, be honest.
- When your manager asks you about you, be honest.

BEING HONEST

- Being *positive* while being honest can be difficult.
 - Positive Phrasing
 - Focus on what is in their control

- Have a discussion beforehand with your manager.
 - Preferred avenue for receiving feedback
 - Preferred *styles* of receiving feedback

TIP 2: COMMUNICATE

- Clear, open, and honest channels of communication.
 - Need to know
 - Regular updates
 - Chat when you can
- Frequency is key
 - Weekly/Bi-Monthly1:1 Meetings

 - Types of Contact
 - Digital vs. Physical

- Non-verbalCommunication
 - Recognition

TIP 3: UNDERSTAND SYSTEM GOALS



- Steering the Ship
 - Where can I help?
 - "Big Picture"
- Vision, Purpose, and Goals
 - What are we here for?
 - What do we need to achieve daily?
 - How does your role fit into everything?

EXAMPLE

- At Hillsborough County Public Library Cooperative (HCPLC) in Tampa, FL, one of their goals is to provide our customers access to cutting-edge technology.
 - Librarians
 - Library and Technology Guide 2
 - Library and Technology Guide 1
 - Library Associate

TIP 4: SOLVE PROBLEMS



- Solutions-based
 - Try to answer questions
 - Repair and Patch if you can
 - Don't leave it leaky

- If it is within your sphere, own it.
 - Branch technology?
 - Book displays?
 - Simple clean up?

TIP 5: STAY CALM AND COOL

- Calm and Cool
 - Proactive vs. Reactive
 - Tempering Expectations
 - Feedback

• Teamwork!




TIP 6: SHARE YOUR KNOWLEDGE


